




Motorcycle fatalities continued to increase in 2012...

...up over 2% from 2011 ...almost 14% from 2010 ...over 19% from 2009

Alcohol involvement in cyclists' deaths fairly constant.. overall deaths are increasing...that means more drunk motorcyclist's deaths...no good!






Immediate goal

Laws passed by the GA to prevent


